

NOTICE OF VACANCY IN OFFICE OF DIRECTOR OF THERMALITO WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Government Code section 1780(d)(1) that a vacancy in the office of director of Thermalito Water and Sewer District for Division 2 exists. All letters of interest shall be presented to the board of directors at its regular meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. at the District offices at 410 Grand Avenue, Oroville, California. If you submit a letter seeking appointment to the position of director of the District, you should plan on attending such meeting, since the remaining members of the board of directors intend to interview persons interested in such appointment at that time before making any appointment.
